## What's on the exterior?

We have two glass jars sitting in the welcome area of the church. Beside the jars is a sign that says "We're painting the church. You pick the color." One jar represents *neutral ground* and the other jar is for *gray clouds*.\*

They are out there for three reasons:

- 1) to finalize the paint color for the exterior of the church building
- 2) to raise funds to pay for the paint project
- 3) to have fun picking the color as a community.

The process of preparing to paint the exterior of the church has gotten me thinking about the relationship between the health of our interior spiritual lives and what shows on the exterior. The familiar quote, "It's what's on the inside that matters" comes to mind. I agree with the sentiment that our personalities and integrity matter much more than our looks. However, when it comes to our spiritual lives, the impact of God's abundant love should not remain only beneath the surface. In Galatians 5:22-23, it says "**The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.**"

This fruit is first nurtured inside of ourselves, but it is fruit that is lived out in community. When we are filled with love inside of ourselves, we cannot help but to share that love with others. When joy makes us dance, others can see the lightness in our steps. When peace grounds us, calm radiates out into the situations around us. The fruit of the Spirit is grown inside of our souls, but it is lived out in very external ways that impact our families, friends, and even the world.

So this month, as you interact with the people around you, take note of how you are treating others. Are you living as if the fruit of the Spirit is well nurtured within you or is your exterior pointing out to you that the soil of your soul is cracked and dry? Notice, breathe, and invite Love in.

## Metigoshe Quilt Auction

Several members of "Threads of Love" quilters attended Metigoshe Ministries Quilt Auction. The quilters donated 12 quilts for the faith filled mission of summer camps and retreats, where attendees experience and celebrate the gifts of God. Funds raised help hire energetic and faithful counselors, and to assist with camperships to make certain no child is turned away from camp due to financial difficulties. Special weeks are dedicated to Ojibwa campers and adult special needs participants.

There were 181 beautiful quilts auctioned, raising \$94,015. Our donated quilts raised \$4,150!! We experienced so much energy and excitement, especially when our quilts were being auctioned off. The quilters stayed at the Lakeside Christian Center two nights and attended Sunday church services. One cannot measure this experience as we were inspired by the beautiful setting in the Turtle Mountains and the promises of God! We will forever treasure our adventure "Anchored in Christ!"
